

PRIVACY POLICY VENDUEHUIS DER NOTARISSEN IN THE HAGUE

This privacy policy contains information regarding the protection of personal data by the Venduehuis. We greatly value our customers' privacy, and we treat and protect your personal data with the utmost care.

In accordance with the European General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR), we are what is referred to as the "responsible" party with regards to processing your personal data. This means that we decide which personal data are processed, to what end, and in what way. We are responsible for processing your personal data in a reasonable and careful manner as laid out in the GDPR.

This privacy policy applies to all our services and agreements. By using our website or entering into an agreement with the Venduehuis, you agree to our privacy policy.

PERSONAL DATA

"Personal data" refers to all data that may provide information about an identifiable natural person. We use, collect, and manage your name, address, phone number(s), email address(es), and bank details, amongst others. In addition, we save your bidding history and/or your purchase history and/or your sales history. We require this information to contact you, and to be able to execute and deliver on agreements made with you. These data are also used to maintain customer relations and to send you informative communications relating to our company. When you visit us online, we may be able to monitor how you use our website with cookies. Further, in and around the premises of the Venduehuis, we use 24/7 camera surveillance to counter theft and to protect our customers and employees.

IMPLEMENTATION OF AGREEMENTS

We process your personal data for the purpose of making agreements and executing these agreements with regards to the auction services we provide, for example by informing you about these services; invoicing sales and purchases; processing payments; and enabling you to place a bid or bids in our (online) auctions, to consign goods for auction, and to collect purchased goods. If necessary for executing an agreement, we will provide these data to third parties, such as couriers. We have entered into agreements with these third parties to ensure they will treat these data carefully and solely for the purpose for which they have been provided.

If you contact us through our website or by email, any data you send us will be stored. However, they will be stored no longer than is necessary for the purpose of fully answering any questions you may have or processing your request(s).

NEWSLETTERS

In our newsletter, we inform interested persons about news regarding the Venduehuis. We may also send invites to events and other auction services provided by the Venduehuis. You will only receive this newsletter if you have given us your explicit permission. A link allowing you to unsubscribe is included at the bottom of every newsletter. The email addresses of our subscribers will not be used for any other purposes, unless you have given the Venduehuis permission to do so, and will never be disclosed to third parties without your explicit permission.

CAMERA FOOTAGE

To protect our property and the safety of our customers and staff, we use visible and hidden security cameras. In the event of misconduct, we will share camera footage with the police, court, and third parties in accordance with the prevailing laws and regulations and the Dutch Data Protection Authority (Autoriteit Persoonsgegevens).

COOKIES

We collect information about visitors to optimise and personalise our website. In addition, some of our visitors' data is used in aggregate form for statistical analysis, to see how visitors use our website and to offer other products and/or services. The collected data are anonymised as much as possible and will never be disclosed to third parties without your explicit permission. Our employees are required to safeguard the confidentiality of your personal data. Our website uses "cookies" to retrieve the data mentioned above. Cookies are small text files that may be sent to and stored in your browser. You are not required to allow the use of these cookies. However, this may make your browsing experience less user friendly. You can delete any saved cookies in your browser.

GOOGLE ANALYTICS

To track and analyse how visitors use our website, we use Google Analytics. More information about how Google Analytics works is available at <http://www.google.com/analytics/learn/privacy.html>. In addition, the Venduehuis follows guidelines provided by the Dutch DPA to ensure any data collected by Google Analytics is used with consideration for your privacy. This means we have a processing agreement with Google: we anonymise your IP address; Google is not permitted to collect our visitors' personal data for their own purposes; and Google Analytics' options for advertising purposes and user IDs have been disabled.

To give our visitors more control over which data Google Analytics collects, Google has developed the [Google Analytics Opt-out Browser Add-on](#). This add-on communicates with the JavaScript code of Google Analytics (ga.js) to indicate that details about your visit to our website may not be sent to Google Analytics. The Google Analytics Opt-Out Browser Add-On does not prevent data from being sent to the website itself or to other web analysis services.

SOCIAL MEDIA

Our website contains buttons that link to social media such as Twitter, Facebook, Instagram, LinkedIn, etc. You can use these buttons to promote our website or share it on these social media. Please note we are not responsible for the privacy policies of Twitter, Facebook, Instagram, LinkedIn, etc. These third parties determine independently how their social media services function. By clicking a social media link, a cookie will be stored in your browser.

YOUR PERSONAL DATA & THIRD PARTIES

The Venduehuis will never disclose your personal data to third parties, unless i) the information is disclosed by the Venduehuis to a third party for a purpose or the purposes described in this privacy policy, in which case the Venduehuis and the third party have come to an agreement to ensure your personal data is properly safeguarded; ii) the Venduehuis is required by law to disclose personal data to public authorities; iii) the Venduehuis is required to disclose these data to a third party due to a court ruling.

PROTECTING YOUR PERSONAL DATA

We take the protection of your personal data very seriously. We are committed to taking the appropriate technical and organisational measures necessary to prevent loss, misuse, and theft of your personal data. Any stored data is protected with a password, and we require anyone who has access to these data to treat them with confidentiality.

RETENTION PERIOD

We do not retain your personal data longer than necessary for processing purposes. At the end of the retention period, or when your data no longer needs to be accessible, your personal data will be destroyed by the Venduehuis.

VIEWING AND CORRECTING YOUR PERSONAL DATA

If you are in contact with the Venduehuis, or have had contact with us in the past, whether via an agreement or in any other way, you have the right to view any of your personal data we have collected, the right to correct these or have these corrected, and the right to delete or have these deleted. You also have the right to request that we transfer any of your personal data to a third party. In addition, you may indicate in writing that you do not wish to be contacted by the Venduehuis regarding our auction services.

If you wish to know which of your personal data we store, you can submit a written request to view these data.

Should you have any complaints about how we process your personal data, please contact us so we can resolve the matter with you. The GDPR also grants you the right to submit a complaint to the Dutch Data Protection Authority.
